Dear Prospective CS Minor:

All applicants must have a declared major and a minimum 2.8 technical GPA (includes the required lower division CS courses and any upper division courses counted towards the minor that you may have completed at the time of applying). Note that in order to successfully complete the CS minor you must finish with a minimum 3.0 GPA among all required courses for the program.

Computer Science minors will be allowed to enroll in upper division CS courses **with higher priority than other non-CS majors**. Although you have higher priority, the department cannot guarantee your enrollment into some of the upper division courses.

Notation of the minor will be posted on your final UC Berkeley transcript pending successful completion of the coursework. A minor notation will not appear on your diploma.
